The Great Welsh Revival

From the middle of the 18th century to the middle of the 19th, Wales experienced some 15 major revivals with many other smaller ones, resulting in it being called the land of revivals.

The last great revival of this period was in 1859. During the rest of the 19th century there was much local religious activity. Many wondered when the next major move of the Spirit would break forth. Then God began to call on some of His people to seek Him in hours of prayer specially to call on Him for revival.

During 1904-05 thousands of meetings were held. Evan Roberts alone held 200. Many of them lasted till 3 a.m.

It was reported that 100,000 sinners sought Christ in Wales alone. And it spread sporadically to the rest of the British Isles, the United States, France, Turkey, India, and many other countries.

From the first meeting with his home church youth group in September 1904, Evan called on everyone to:

- 1) confess all known sin,
- 2) get rid of anything doubtful in your life,
- 3) Be ready to obey the Holy Spirit in your life,
- 4) Confess Christ publicly.

As a result, it was reported that pubs were empty, swearing virtually disappeared, work in the mines began with prayer, judges had scarcely any cases to try, football games were canceled, clubs disbanded, and churches were open for prayer day and night.

The Salvation Army set apart January 19th, 1905 for a day of confession, humiliation, and prayer throughout Britain. All day prayer meetings were held in many of the principal cities. Fires of spiritual revival and moral recovery were already spreading.

For years ministers and laymen had met in groups to pray for revival.

Seth Joshua, a leading Bible teacher, spent 4 hours a day asking God to raise up someone to present revival truths.

Evan Roberts had already prayed for 13 years for the Holy Spirit to control him. Now he determined to read and speak often about revival. He began spending 7 hours in prayer and Bible study daily.

The Welsh Revival was not an orgy of emotion but an outpouring of spiritual fervor, bringing a whole nation to its knees at the foot of the cross in adoration and praise.

Only God can bring such revival.

Only God can raise up the necessary leaders. Only God can raise up the needed prayer warriors. Will you let Him use you?

Jesus Christ - the King of kings and Lord of lords!
