Blood on Your Hands

"17) Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the house of Israel: therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me. (18) When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand. (19) Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul." (Ezekiel 3:17-19)

A Christian was driving down a rural road.

Ahead, he saw a man walking. There was something about the walker that compelled the driver to give him a ride.

Immediately, the driver felt a tug in his spirit to talk to him about the Lord. But, as he debated the point, the man asked to be let off. It was too late.

The next morning as the Christian read his newspaper, he was suddenly brought up short in shock.
